RE: **Request for Approval of Administrative Modification #7 for the FY2011-2015 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)**

ACTION REQUESTED:

Request for approval of Administrative Modification #7 for the FY2011-2015 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

BACKGROUND:

On June 28, 2011, the Urban Balancing Committee met to balance the Surface Transportation Program – Urban funding. The Canyon Highway District #4 requested \$16,000 for their Middleton Road Pavement Rehabilitation project because the bid for project development came in above the estimated amount.

STATUS:

The following changes are proposed to the FY2011-2015 Regional Transportation Improvement Program:

Per the Urban Balancing Committee on June 28, 2011:

- **Middleton Road Pavement Rehabilitation, Canyon County (12377)** – Increase Preliminary Engineering Consulting by \$16,000 to cover costs over the estimated amount. Funds are from key number 09854, a project in the City of Heyburn that delayed right-of-way acquisition.

Details of the changes are provided in Attachment 1.
