RE: **Request for Approval of Administrative Modification #8 for the FY2009-2013 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)**

ACTION REQUESTED:

Request for approval of Administrative Modification #8 for the FY2009-2013 Regional Transportation Improvement Program.

BACKGROUND:

Changes to the FY2009-2013 TIP are proposed through requests of the City of Nampa, TMA Balancing Committee action, and staff review. The proposed changes are consistent with the TIP Amendment policy to take place through an Administrative Modification.

STATUS:

A summary of changes is shown below, with details provided on Attachment 1.

- The Nampa City Council recently approved the Amity Road project to enter a phase II contract to take the project through design, right-of-way acquisition, and construction. The City requested funds move to appropriate categories and years in the TIP. Policy states we can add or adjust Congressional earmark projects through this process.
- The TMA Balancing Committee approved changes to two projects on May 7, 2009. These are minor changes to KN 07238 and 08698.
- The remaining entries provide corrections that match actions taken by ITD to reflect actual costs or minor adjustments.
 - Two key numbers are removed, but are combined with other existing projects.
 - One project has a correcting entry from Administrative Modification #6.

Approval:

All changes for Administrative Modification #8, as provided in this memorandum and detailed on Attachment 1, are approved as of May 29, 2009.
