Voting open for Treasure Valley: On the Go! photo contest through
Tuesday, September 14, 2016***

Meridian, ID – The public is invited to vote to select winning photos for the Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) *Treasure Valley: On the Go!* transportation photo contest. The winning photos will be used in a 2017 *Treasure Valley: On the Go!* calendar.

Voting will remain open through Tuesday, September 14, 2016; access an online ballot by visiting www.compassidaho.org and following the link to "*Treasure Valley: On the Go!* voting."

COMPASS solicited transportation photos from Ada and Canyon County residents from August 2015 through July 2016. The photos depict how residents use their transportation system as they are "on the go" in their daily lives. In total, 116 photos were submitted by 34 individuals from around the valley.

The photos represent the four transportation components (bicycle/pedestrian, freight, public transportation, and roadway) that will be included in the next long-range transportation plan for Ada and Canyon Counties, [*Communities in Motion 2040 2.0*](#).

Entries were narrowed to 41 finalists, which are now open for public voting. Everyone is welcome – and encouraged – to vote.
