A. Review Current and Upcoming Legislative Activity

Ken Burgess provided an update on the following legislative activity:

- Enhanced Transportation Funding Legislation

Ken recapped 15 bills relating to transportation funding that have been introduced in the House Transportation Committee.

- GARVEE

Activity on GARVEE is on hold until after it is determined if any of the stimulus money can be applied to any of the current GARVEE projects.

- STAR Legislation

The House Revenue and Taxation Committee sent Representative Moyle's STAR Legislation Amendment Bill, HB119, to the House floor with a do pass recommendation.

Senators Winder and McGee will cosponsor the legislation on the Senate side.

- Idaho Transportation Board - District 3 Seat

The Governor has not yet made a decision on the District 3 vacancy.

- Other

Matt Stoll noted there is a Special Idaho Transportation Board meeting on March 2, 2009, to discuss the stimulus package and to prioritize projects.


