CALL TO ORDER

Chair Crystal Craig called the meeting to order at 8:30 am.

OPEN DISCUSSION/ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Tom Laws introduced Cody Homan, the new Accessibility and Mobility Supervisor with the Ada County Highway District.
- Matt Carlson reminded RTAC that there will be a Project Development Program/Communities in Motion Implementation grant workshop following the RTAC meeting.

CONSENT AGENDA

A. Approve April 25, 2025, RTAC Meeting Minutes

Stephen Hunt moved and Tom Laws seconded approval of the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

SPECIAL ITEM

A. State Highway 69 Corridor Traffic Study

Leah Kelsey, Six Mile Engineering, and Mark Wasdahl, Idaho Transportation Department, presented on the State Highway 69 Corridor Traffic Study.

ACTION ITEMS

A. Recommend Balancing in the Transportation Management Area (TMA)

Toni Tisdale presented items for balancing in the TMA.

After discussion, Caleb Hood moved and Brent Moore seconded recommendation of approval of balancing actions in the TMA program as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Recommend Priorities for the End-of-Year and Redistribution Program

Toni Tisdale presented recommended priorities for the End-of-Year and Redistribution Program and requested assistance to rank eligible projects that are tied.

After discussion, Caleb Hood moved and Stephen Hunt seconded to recommend COMPASS Board of Directors' approval of the End-of-Year and Redistribution program priorities in the order presented with the funding amount for the City of Meridian, Pathway, Rail with Trail project (KN13918) changed from \$300,000 to \$100,000, and to include the City of Caldwell Pedestrian Improvements and Widening, Montana Avenue project (KN22018) if the letter of request for additional funding is provided from the City of Caldwell. Motion passed unanimously.

C. Recommend Statewide Functional Classification System update within the COMPASS Planning Area

Mary Ann Waldinger presented an update of the Statewide Functional Classification System.

After discussion, **Tom Laws moved and Nichole Baird Spencer seconded to recommend COMPASS Board of Directors' adoption of a resolution approving the Statewide Functional Classification System within Ada and Canyon Counties.** Motion passed unanimously.
