#### **CONSENT AGENDA**

#### A. Approve the July 24, 2024, RTAC Meeting Minutes

Lenny Riccio moved and Tom Laws seconded approval of the Consent Agenda as **presented.** Motion passed unanimously.

#### **ACTION ITEMS**

#### A. Recommend Adoption of an Amendment to Communities in Motion 2050

Austin Miller presented a resolution for an amendment to Communities in Motion 2050.
