## Communities in Motion 2040 Development Review

## Recommendations

The proposal provides transit-oriented density housing near a public park, public school, and a grocery store, providing opportunities for shorter vehicular trips and more non-motorized trips. Valleyride route \#7A runs along Milwaukee and Ustick Road, providing service to downtown Boise. ValleyConnect 2.0 proposes to create a Ustick Road service connecting the Village at Meridian with downtown Boise and the Boise Airport. Frequencies are proposed to be 15 minutes in peak hours as well as providing late night service. Please coordinate transit facility improvements with Valley Regional Transit (VRT). VRT has developed a Bus Stop Location and Transit Amenities Development Guidelines for siting new bus stops and reviewing current and bus stops. More information is available at:
