COMPASS Seeks Nominations for 2025 Leadership in Motion Awards

Meridian, ID – The Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) is seeking nominations for its 2025 Leadership in Motion awards. The awards recognize projects, businesses, nonprofits, and individuals that demonstrate leadership in implementing the region's long-range transportation plan, [*Communities in Motion 2050*](#).

"*Communities in Motion* plans for a future transportation system that supports regional goals of safety, economic vitality, convenience, and quality of life," explains COMPASS Executive Director Craig Raborn. "The Leadership in Motion awards recognize leaders and projects that help 'move the needle' toward achieving these goals and shine a spotlight on good ideas that others could emulate."

Awards will be presented in the following categories:

- Leadership in Government: Ada County, Boise County, and Canyon County
 - Government-sponsored projects
 - Three awards total; one in each county
- Leadership in Private Business/Nonprofit
- Leadership in Practice, Professional
- Leadership in Practice, Individual/Volunteer
- Leadership by Example, Elected/Appointed Official

This year's awards will recognize efforts and projects that occurred between July 2024 and June 2025.

Anyone may submit a nomination and any project, business, or person (other than COMPASS staff) within Ada, Boise, or Canyon Counties is eligible to be nominated. Nominations must be received by 12:00 noon, Friday, September 26, 2025. Awards will be presented in December.
