COMPASS Seeks Public Comment on Coordinated Mobility Plan Public Comment Period: April 15 – May 15, 2022

Meridian, ID – The Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) is seeking public comment on the draft *2022 Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Transportation Plan for Ada and Canyon Counties* ("Coordinated Plan").

The Coordinated Plan identifies transportation needs of older adults and individuals with disabilities, low incomes, and limited English proficiency, then outlines strategies to meet the highest priority needs. Those strategies will be used to help identify and prioritize public transportation projects for funding. COMPASS has worked closely with Valley Regional Transit to develop the plan.

COMPASS is looking for feedback on the draft plan - particularly the identified needs and strategies - before the plan is finalized. Public comments will be accepted from April 15 through May 15, 2022.

"If you, or a family member or friend, rely on public transportation to meet your daily needs, this plan is for you," explains COMPASS Assistant Planner Lila Klopfenstein. "Review the needs that have been identified and let us know if they match yours, then check out the strategies to meet those needs. Did we miss anything?"
