## Communities in Motion 2040 2.0 Development Review

The Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) is the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for Ada and Canyon Counties. COMPASS has developed this review as a tool for local governments to evaluate whether land developments are consistent with the goals of *Communities in Motion 2040 2.0* (CIM 2040), the regional long-range transportation plan for Ada and Canyon Counties. This checklist is not intended to be prescriptive, but rather a guidance document based on CIM 2040 2.0 goals.

## Recommendations

The COMPASS Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) has identified the widening of State Highway 55 (Karcher Road) from Midway Road to Middleton Road. The project will add one travel lane in each direction to improve mobility and reduce crashes along the corridor (Key #22716).

The proposal provides multi-family housing near a bus route and grocery store. Several bus routes make a stop at the Karcher Mall as well as many new virtual stops, within one mile from this proposal. ValleyConnect 2.0 also proposes to serve multiple future bus routes near this location.


