- <u>2022 Federal Transportation Position Statements</u>. Recommended 2022 federal positions statements for COMPASS Board of Directors' approval. The Board of Directors will be asked to approve the recommended statements in its December 20, 2021, meeting. The recommended position statements will be reviewed in light of the recently passed Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act and any suggested changes will be brought to the COMPASS Executive Committee and Board of Directors for review and potential action at a future date.
- <u>2022 Idaho Legislative Position Statements</u>. Recommended 2022 Idaho legislative position statements for COMPASS Board of Directors' approval. The Board of Directors will be asked to approve the recommended statements in its December 20, 2021, meeting.

### **November Special Item:**

• <u>ITD Projects</u>. Received an update on Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) Transportation Expansion and Congestion Mitigation (TECM) projects in Ada and Canyon Counties.

#### **November Action Items:**

- Affordable Housing. Received an overview from a Boise State University class on how parking requirements can affect the cost of building
  affordable housing and formed an RTAC subcommittee to provide input into the integration of affordable housing into COMPASS planning.
- <u>CIM 2040 2.0 and TIPs</u>. Recommended amendments to *Communities in Motion 2040 2.0* (CIM 2040 2.0) and the FY2021-2027 and FY2022-2028 Regional Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) to add one project to CIM 2040 2.0 and both TIPs and remove four projects from both TIPs. This item will be brought to the COMPASS Board of Directors for action in its December 20, 2021, meeting.
- <u>TMA Balancing</u>. Approved actions to balance the Surface Transportation Block Grant program and Transportation Alternatives Program in the Transportation Management Area (TMA).
- <u>Complete Network Policy</u>. Recommended COMPASS Board of Directors' approval of the COMPASS Complete Network Policy to replace the 2009 Complete Streets Policy. The policy will be brought to the COMPASS Board of Directors for action in its December 20, 2021, meeting.
