• <u>CIM 2050</u>. Recommended COMPASS Board of Directors' adoption of *Communities in Motion 2050*, the next regional long-range transportation plan for Ada and Canyon Counties. The draft plan will be brought to the COMPASS Board of Directors for action in its December 19, 2022, meeting.

- <u>TIP Amendment</u>.
