Boise State University, Elder Street Park and Ride Facility

The Elder Street Park and Ride facility was developed with dual goals of increasing multimodal infrastructure and decreasing individual vehicle usage in the downtown Boise area, including the Boise State University campus. Boise State worked with Valley Regional Transit and the Ada County Highway District to create a facility to serve not only the university, but also the community as a whole, providing a meeting place for carpoolers, a conduit to the public transportation system, and a bike-to-destination parking option.

Located off of Interstate 84 at the Vista Street exit, the facility provides 149 paved parking spaces and includes a bus shelter, gated shuttle storage, and bike parking.
