January Action Items:

- TMA Balancing. Recommended actions to apply funding released from projects in the Transportation Management Area (TMA) to other projects with funding needs.
- TIP Amendment. Recommended COMPASS Board of Directors' approval of an amendment to the FY2026-2032 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to make a correction to the scope of one project and add a new safety project and a new transit project awarded through federally competitive grant funding. This item will be brought to the Board of Directors for action in its February 23, 2026, meeting.
- Let's Ride Treasure Valley. Recommended COMPASS Board of Directors' approval of the Let's Ride Treasure Valley high-capacity transit planning and environmental linkages study findings. This item will be brought to the Board of Directors for action in its February 23, 2026, meeting.
- Safety Targets. Recommended COMPASS Board of Directors' adoption of FY2026 safety performance targets and received a status update on performance measures from the Regional Safety Action Plan. This item will be brought to the Board of Directors for action in its February 23, 2026, meeting.
