## Communities in Motion 2040 Development Review

## Recommendations

The Overland Road Multimodal Corridor Plan is the \#19 priority in the Communities in Motion 2040 plan. Overland Road serves as a regional corridor south of Interstate 84 and is an alternate route to the interstate. More information about the Overland Road Multimodal Corridor Plan is available at:

The location is nearby a large employment center at the intersection of Eagle Road and Overland Road. Consider automobile access that enables adjacent neighborhoods to reach the commercial pads along Overland Road from East Gala Street without adding traffic onto Overland Road. Consider pedestrian circulation that enables bicyclists and pedestrians to reach the commercial pads. One possible solution is developing the pathway to the east of the storage facility along the canal easement.
