- Communities in Motion 2050. Adopted Communities in Motion 2050 as the regional long-range transportation plan for Ada and Canyon Counties.
- <u>UPWP</u>. Adopted <u>Revision 1</u> of the FY2023 Unified Planning Work Program and Budget (UPWP).
- <u>FY2022-2028 and FY2023-2029 TIPs</u>. Adopted a resolution <u>amending</u> the FY2022-2028 and FY2023-2029 Regional Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) to add six projects, remove one project, and adjust seven projects.
- <u>2023 Federal Transportation Position Statements</u>. Approved the <u>2023 federal transportation position statements</u> addressing reauthorization of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, transportation funding, and other policy issues.
- <u>2023 Idaho Legislative Position Statements</u>. Approved the <u>2023 Idaho state legislative position statements</u> addressing multiple transportation revenue and policy issues.
- Change in Motion. Accepted the 2022 Change in Motion scorecard, highlighting regional progress toward meeting Communities in Motion goals.
