- <u>UPWP</u>. Adopted Revision 1 of the FY2025 Unified Planning Work Program and Budget (UPWP).
- <u>CIM 2055 Population Allocation</u>. Approved the population allocation for *Communities in Motion 2055* (CIM 2055). The allocation establishes the official growth scenario and demographic assumptions for CIM 2055 transportation analyses.
- <u>2025 COMPASS Board Officer Slate</u>. - <u>Regional Safety Action Plan</u>. Recommended COMPASS Board of Directors' acceptance of the Regional Safety Action Plan and adoption of a resolution stating the Board's commitment to plan and program projects to achieve an interim target of a 50% reduction in fatal and serious injury crashes by 2055.
- <u>TMA Balancing</u>. Recommended an action to balance the Surface Transportation Block Grant and Transportation Alternatives Programs in the Transportation Management Area (TMA) to allocate available funding to two Ada County Highway District projects.
