June Special Item:

• <u>Treasure Valley Survey</u>. Received results from Boise State University's 2019 Treasure Valley survey.

June Action Items:

- Executive Director Annual Review. Voted to retain the COMPASS Executive Director, and approved a corresponding salary adjustment, following a discussion in Executive Session.
- Long-Range Transportation Plan. Approved the work plan for the next long-range transportation plan, Communities in Motion 2050, as recommended by the Regional Transportation Advisory Committee (RTAC) in May. Work on the plan will begin immediately; the plan must be adopted no later than December 2022.
- <u>End-of-Year Priorities</u>. Approved priorities for the End-of-Year program and redistribution, should funding become available, as recommended by RTAC in May.
- <u>UPWP</u>. Approved Revision 3 of the FY2019 Unified Planning Work Program and Budget (UPWP), as recommended by the Finance Committee in May, to allow work on *Communities in Motion 2050* to begin immediately.
- <u>FY2019-2023 TIP</u>. Approved an <u>amendment</u> to the FY2019-2023 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add two rural public transportation projects; remove an Ada County Highway District Intelligent Transportation Systems project and return the funding to the Federal Highway Administration; and remove a Valley Regional Transit Bike Share project, and move the funds to five other projects, as recommended by RTAC in May.
- <u>Ada County Air Quality Board</u>. Approved moving forward with a process to incorporate the Ada County Air Quality Board into COMPASS, as recommended by the Executive Committee on June 4, 2019.
- <u>Parking Lot Offer</u>. Declined an offer from the Meridian Development Corporation for COMPASS/Valley Regional Transit to purchase the parking lot that serves the COMPASS/Valley Regional Transit offices.

June Information/Discussion Item:

• <u>FY2020-2026 TIP</u>. Received the draft FY2020-2026 TIP project list for review prior to release for public comment. Agency changes to the draft TIP are due to COMPASS no later than July 12, 2019.
