December Action Items:

- <u>UPWP</u>. Adopted <u>Revision 1</u> of the FY2020 Unified Planning Work Program and Budget (UPWP).
- <u>2020 Idaho Legislative Position Statements</u>. Approved <u>2020 Idaho legislative position statements</u> addressing transportation revenue, local option sales tax authority, funding for public transportation, high occupancy vehicle lanes, non-motorized transportation, the use of hands-free electronic devices while driving, and a weight/distance fee for heavy vehicles.
- <u>2020 Federal Transportation Position Statements</u>. Approved <u>2020 federal transportation position statements</u> addressing reauthorization of the FAST (Fixing American's Surface Transportation) Act, long-term solvency of the Highway Trust Fund, and rail corridor use.
- <u>2050 Demographic Forecast</u>. Approved a population forecast for the year 2050 for Ada and Canyon Counties of 1,075,000 individuals. This forecast will be used as the basis for developing *Communities in Motion 2050*, the next regional long-range transportation plan.
- <u>National Highway System</u>. Approved recommended changes to the National Highway System in Ada and Canyon Counties. COMPASS staff will submit the required materials to finalize the changes.
- <u>FY2019-2023 and FY2020-2026 TIPs</u>. Approved an <u>amendment</u> to the FY2019-2023 and FY2020-2026 Regional Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) to fund cost increases for four projects.
- <u>2020 COMPASS Board Officer Slate</u>. Approved the following slate of officers for the COMPASS Board of Directors for 2020: Chair, Councilmember Elaine Clegg; Chair Elect, Mayor Garret Nancolas; Vice Chair, Mayor Joe Stear; Secretary/Treasurer, Mayor Debbie Kling; Immediate Past Chair, Commissioner Tom Dale.
