April Action Items:

• <u>CIM 2040 2.0</u>. Adopted a resolution amending *Communities in Motion 2040 2.0* (CIM 2040 2.0) to add two new funded projects on State Highway 44 (State Street) between the City of Eagle and downtown Boise to improve transit service. This action was brought to the COMPASS Board of Directors for ratification in its April 19, 2021, meeting (above).

- <u>FY2021-2027 TIP</u>. Adopted a resolution amending the FY2021-2027 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the same two funded projects on State Highway 44 (State Street) as above and to modify the configuration of the State Highway 44 and State Highway 55 intersection improvement project from a half Continuous Flow Intersection to a conventional intersection. This action was brought to the COMPASS Board of Directors for ratification in its April 19, 2021, meeting (above).
- Legislative Issues. Received a status report on state legislative issues. No action was taken.

April Action Items:

- <u>Performance Measures</u>. Reviewed proposed performance measures for CIM 2050 and established a subcommittee to review the proposed measures in more detail and work with COMPASS staff to develop corresponding targets.
- <u>TMA Balancing</u>. Recommended actions to balance the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) program and Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) in the Transportation Management Area (TMA) to cover shortfalls of formula funding due to limited obligation authority and allocate additional new funding. This item will be brought to the COMPASS Board of Directors for action in its June 21, 2021, meeting.

April Information/Discussion Item:

- <u>Survey Results</u>. Reviewed a summary of "All Aboard" transit survey results and primary themes, discussed which transit modes and alignments would best meet regional needs as demonstrated in survey results, and discussed next steps. RTAC will be asked to recommend a "locally favored" alignment and mode to the COMPASS Board of Directors in its May 26, 2021, RTAC meeting.
- <u>Performance Measures</u>. Reviewed and discussed recommendations from an RTAC subcommittee that examined under-performing CIM 2040 2.0 performance measures.
- Resilience. Received a report on research into resilience practices and their application to transportation in the Treasure Valley and discussed recommendations of how resilience can be addressed in CIM 2050.
- <u>STBG-Urban Funds</u>. Discussed research conducted by the City of Nampa and COMPASS staff into the allocation of STBG-Urban funds in Idaho and discussed proposed steps to work with the Idaho Transportation Department to update its policy to more equitably allocate funding to urban areas.
