## Communities in Motion 2040 Development Review

## Recommendations

The proposal is on the fringe or urban development in an area removed from employment centers, public parks, grocery stores, and existing public transportation. The closest transit services are located more than two miles away.

Consider reconfiguring the internal street networks to encourage a safe pedestrian environment. The road that parallels Alma Lane is approximately $3 / 4$ mile in length. Many driveways will have direct access to this new road and provides access to the internal, private park. Consider bulbouts, speed bumps, or other traffic calming measures to discourage speeding and improving safety for all modes.
