October Action Items:

- <u>CIM 2040 2.0 and TIP</u>. Approved amendments to <u>Communities in Motion 2040 2.0</u> (CIM 2040 2.0) and the <u>FY2022-2028 Regional Transportation Improvement Program</u> (TIP) and approved the <u>FY2023-2029 TIP</u> and the associated <u>air quality conformity demonstration</u>. Final federal approval of the FY2023-2029 TIP is expected by the end of December 2022. The FY2022-2028 TIP will remain in effect until that time.
- Resource Development Plan. Approved the <u>FY2023 Resource Development Plan</u>. This plan will be used to guide COMPASS resource development activities, such as assisting member agencies in finding and applying for grants, throughout FY2023.
- <u>Rural Project Priorities</u>. Adopted a resolution demonstrating approval and support for rural project priorities in Ada and Canyon Counties. COMPASS support for these priorities will provide additional points in the Local Highway Technical Assistance Council's statewide prioritization process.
- <u>Planning and Environmental Linkages Workgroup</u>. Approved the charter for a <u>Planning and Environmental Linkages Workgroup</u>, which will develop a scope of work for a high-capacity transit planning study.

• <u>CIM 2050</u>. Received an overview and status report on the draft <u>Communities in Motion 2050</u> (CIM 2050) long-range transportation plan. The final plan will be brought to the COMPASS Board of Directors for action in its December 19, 2022, meeting.
