CONSENT AGENDA

A. Approve May 11, 2021, Executive Committee Meeting Minutes

Mary May moved and Robert Simison seconded approval of the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

ACTION ITEMS

A. Establish August 16, 2021, COMPASS Board Meeting Agenda

Matt Stoll reviewed the COMPASS Board Meeting agenda for the August 16, 2021 meeting.

After discussion, Elaine Clegg moved and Steve Rule seconded approval of Items 1-22, including items proposed for the Consent Agenda, for the August 16, 2021, COMPASS Board of Directors meeting. Matt Stoll has the latitude to amend the agenda as necessary. Motion passed unanimously.
