Background/Summary:

RTAC Bylaws state that the RTAC Chair will submit a monthly status report on RTAC activities to the COMPASS Executive Committee. Below is an outline of agenda items and actions from the January 25, 2023, meeting.

ACTION ITEM

RTAC Chair and Vice Chair

RTAC elected Lee Belt, City of Greenleaf, as Chair and Miranda Carson, City of Meridian, as Vice Chair.

COMPASS Development Review Policy and Revised Development Review Checklist

RTAC recommended COMPASS Board of Directors' approval of the new Development Review Policy and revised Development Review Checklist template. This item will be brought to the COMPASS Board of Directors for action in its February 27, 2023, meeting.

Transportation Management Area (TMA) Balancing

RTAC approved a balancing action for the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) - TMA program to allocate funding released from projects entering closeout or bid cost savings to Ada County Highway District and Valley Regional Transit projects.

FY2023-2029 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

RTAC recommended COMPASS Board of Directors' adoption of a resolution amending the FY2023-2029 TIP to add two projects and change the scope of three projects. This item will be brought to the COMPASS Board of Directors for action in its February 27, 2023, meeting.

Scoring Criteria

COMPASS staff reviewed the current project scoring process. RTAC established a subcommittee to determine if additional criteria are needed to score projects for the Carbon Reduction Program. The volunteers for the subcommittee are Tom Ferch (ACHD), Nichoel Baird Spencer (City of Eagle), Brian McClure (City of Meridian), Tessa Greegor (City of Boise), and Jason Van Gilder (City of Middleton).

INFORMATION ITEMS

Member Agencies' Requests for FY2024 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

COMPASS staff presented an overview of the process for submitting requests for COMPASS staff time of five days or more for COMPASS' FY2024 UPWP. Requests are due to COMPASS no later than February 15, 2023.

Long-Range Planning Functional Classification Map Update Process

COMPASS staff provided an update on the status and next steps for the update to Canyon County's planning functional classification map.
