CALL TO ORDER

Chair Lee Belt called the meeting to order at 8:32 am.

CONSENT AGENDA

A. Approve the March 15, 2023, RTAC Meeting Minutes

Stephen Hunt moved and Brent Moore seconded approval of the Consent Agenda. Motion passed unanimously.

SPECIAL ITEMS

A. Status Report – Carbon Reduction Program

Margaret Havey with the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) provided a status report on the Carbon Reduction Program.

B. Status Report – Promoting Resilient Operations for Transformative, Efficient, and Cost-Saving Transportation (PROTECT) Program

Shirley Wentland with ITD provided a status report on the PROTECT program.

ACTION ITEMS

A. Recommend Adoption of Resolution Amending the FY2023-2029 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Toni Tisdale presented a resolution amending the FY2023-2029 TIP to add an ITD project to evaluate signal operations and maintenance practices on state routes in Ada County.

After discussion, Lenny Riccio moved and Nichoel Baird Spencer seconded to continue discussion of this item at the May 24, 2023, Regional Transportation Advisory Committee (RTAC) meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Accept Proposal for a Change of Scope to the US 20/26 (Chinden Boulevard) / 43rd Street Pedestrian Crossing

Tom Ferch, Ada County Highway District (ACHD), presented a proposal to request public comment on a proposed change to the pedestrian crossing project on US 20/26 (Chinden Boulevard) to move the project from 43rd Street to the area of 32nd or 33rd Streets.

After discussion, Stephen Hunt moved and Stacey Yarrington seconded to accept the proposed change, but public comment materials should note that work will continue to find a solution to address pedestrian crossing safety issues at the Chinden Boulevard/43rd Street intersection.

After further discussion, Bre Brush moved and Nichole Baird Spencer seconded a substitute motion to reject the proposal for a change in scope for the Chinden Boulevard/43rd Street intersection and continue the discussion to submit a separate proposal for a crossing at 32nd or 33rd Streets. The substitute motion failed on a roll call vote.

Original motion stands. Stephen Hunt moved and Stacey Yarrington seconded to accept the proposed change, but public comment materials should note that work will continue to find a solution to address pedestrian crossing safety issues at the Chinden Boulevard/43rd Street intersection. Motion passed on a roll call vote.
