## Communities in Motion 2040 2.0 Development Review

The Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) is the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for Ada and Canyon Counties. COMPASS has developed this review as a tool for local governments to evaluate whether land developments are consistent with the goals of Communities in Motion 20402.0 (CIM 2040), the regional long-range transportation plan for Ada and Canyon Counties. This checklist is not intended to be prescriptive, but rather a guidance document based on CIM 20402.0 goals.

## Recommendations

Communities in Motion 20402.0 identifies State Highway 44, from Canyon Lane to Star Road, to be widened to four travel lanes. This project would include 10-foot paved multiuse shoulders along the new roadway in the City of Middleton. This project is the \#3 unfunded state priority. Sections of Highway 44 from Star Road to Linder Road are in the COMPASS Regional Transportation Improvement Program for construction scheduled in 2023 and 2024 (Key \#20574 and Key \#20266).

The site is not currently served by public transportation. ValleyConnect 2.0 proposes bus service from Canyon County to downtown Meridian, via Highway 44. The closest bus stop in downtown Middleton. The proposal is a mix of residential and retail, which can mitigate increased traffic congestion by encouraging non-motorized travel.
