City of Notus Collector Street Rebuild Project

The City of Notus' four main "collector" streets — Notus Road, Jasper Avenue, 1st Street, and 3rd Street — are in poor condition. Their crumbling shoulders, alligator cracking, and lack of drainage systems hinder traffic flow and pose safety risks.

The city is exploring long-term solutions to rebuild these streets and wants your input.

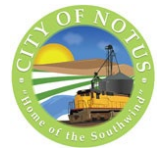

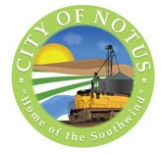

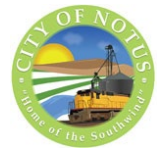
