#### CALL TO ORDER

Chair John Franden called the meeting to order at 1:32 p.m.

Fred Tilman moved and Carol McKee seconded approval of amending the Agenda as requested. Motion passed unanimously.

Carol McKee moved and Fred Tilman seconded approval of the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion passed with Sharon Ullman abstaining

#### A. Confirm and Elect New Board Officers

Matt Stoll stated per the COMPASS Bylaws, each January the Board is required to confirm the rotation of Board officers: Chair, Chair-Elect, and Vice-Chair, and to receive nominations for the Secretary/Treasurer position.

Chair Nancolas presented John Franden with a plaque of recognition for his service as Chair and as a member of the COMPASS Board of Directors.

# B. Confirm Executive Committee Representatives for the Cities under 25,000 in Population

Matt Stoll stated the cities under 25,000 in population nominated Phil Bandy and Vicky Thurber as the small cities representatives on the COMPASS Executive Committee.

Mike Vuittonet moved and Vern Bisterfeldt seconded confirmation of Phil Bandy and Vicky Thurber as the Executive Committee representatives for the cities under 25,000 in population. Motion passed unanimously.

# D. Review Recommended 2035 Population Forecast for Communities in Motion Update

Carl Miller stated a 2035 population forecast of 1,046,000 was recommended by the Demographic Advisory Committee on November 20, 2008, as the control total forecast for Ada and Canyon counties. COMPASS Board approval of the forecast will be requested in spring/summer 2009 as a first step in the *Communities in Motion* update.

# E. Status Report – Finance Committee

David Ferdinand, Finance Committee Vice-Chair, recapped the January 15, 2009, Finance Committee meeting. David stated the Finance Committee received the 2008 Audit and recommended it for Board approval. No material issues were found in the audit.

Tom Dale moved and Carol McKee seconded approval of the 2008 Audit as recommended by the Finance Committee. Motion passed unanimously.

#### Other

Chair Nancolas noted that Charlie Rountree is being considered for the District 3 seat on the Idaho Transportation Board.

After discussion, Vern Bisterfeldt moved and Tom Dale seconded that COMPASS send a letter signed by the COMPASS Chair to the Governor in support of Charlie Rountree for the Idaho Transportation Board District 3 seat. Motion passed unanimously.
