ACTION ITEMS

A. Adopt Resolutions 08-2005 and 09-2005 Amending the FY2005-2009 Nampa Urbanized Area and Northern Ada County Transportation Improvement Programs – Valley Regional Transit

Patricia Nilsson reviewed Resolutions 08-2005 and 09-2005 amending the FY2005-2009 Nampa Urbanized Area and Northern Ada County Transportation Improvement Programs reflecting Valley Regional Transit's use of 5307 funds for operating costs and preventive maintenance, use of 5309 for preventive maintenance and transfer of 5309 funds from Canyon County to Northern Ada County.

Elaine Clegg moved and Matt Beebe seconded adoption of Resolutions 08-2005 and 09-2005 amending the FY2005-2009 Nampa Urbanized Area and Northern Ada County Transportation Improvement Programs as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Consider Establishing Public Participation and Regional Geographic Information System Standing Committees

Charles Trainor discussed establishing Public Participation and Regional Geographic Information System Standing Committees to address regional and transportation planning challenges and needs.

Tom Dale moved and Elaine Clegg seconded the establishment of the Public Participation and Regional Geographic Information System Standing Committees. Motion passed unanimously.

INFORMATION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Status Report – Treasure Valley Regional Transportation Management Center Feasibility Study

Fred Kitchener, McFarland Management, LLC, provided a status report on the Treasure Valley Regional Transportation Management Center Feasibility Study being conducted by the Idaho Transportation Department and Ada County Highway District. The proposed Treasure Valley Regional Management Center would house traffic/transit operations and emergency dispatch. The next workshop is scheduled for March 3, 2005, at the Nampa Civic Center from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. A copy of his Power Point presentation can be requested from COMPASS.

B. Review the Downtown Boise Mobility Study

Kelli Fairless, Toni Tisdale and Sue Sullivan presented an overview of the draft Downtown Boise Mobility Study. Final adoption by sponsoring agencies is expected to occur in April 2005.

D. Review Proposed Projects for Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality Grant Funding by the Idaho Transportation Department

Jay Witt reviewed proposed projects for Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality Grant funding by the Idaho Transportation Department in FY2008.

E. Update on Certification (or Triennial) Review Process

Toni Tisdale provided an update on the Certification (or Triennial) review process. She stated that a site review is scheduled for April 19-21, 2005 and a public hearing will take place on April 20. The final report is expected in mid-June 2005.

F. Review 2005 Federal and State Legislative Issues

Matt Stoll provided a status report on 2005 federal and state legislative issues. He will continue to email updates to the Board regarding the status of each piece of legislation.

G. Review Proposed Actions for Urban and Transportation Management Area Balancing Committee
