Chair Elect Tom Dale called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

AGENDA ADDITIONS/CHANGES

OPEN DISCUSSION/ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chair Elect Dale noted the Executive Committee will begin the Executive Directors' 2018 annual performance review process at its meeting on May 8, 2018. The Executive Committee will forward a recommendation to the COMPASS Board for action at the June 18, 2018, Board meeting.

(Chair Elect Dale turned the meeting over to Chair Case at 1:32 p.m.)

Matt Stoll announced the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration will be conducting their certification review of COMPASS, which is conducted every 4 years, on May 23 and 24, 2018.

Sara Baker moved and Charlie Rountree seconded approval of the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

INFORMATION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Status Report – State and Federal Legislative Activity

Ken Burgess provided a status report on 2018 state legislative activity.

B. Status Report – Finance Committee

Garret Nancolas, Finance Committee Chair, provided a status report on action taken at the March 22, 2018, Finance Committee meeting.

ACTION ITEMS

A. Accept 2018 Population Estimates

Carl Miller presented the 2018 population estimates for Ada and Canyon Counties, which are used for local and regional planning and as a factor to help establish COMPASS membership dues, and recommended for COMPASS Board acceptance by the Demographic Advisory Workgroup.

After discussion, Jim Tibbs moved and Tom Dale seconded to accept the 2018 population estimates as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Approve FY2019 General and Special Member Dues

Megan Larsen presented FY2019 General and Special member dues based on the 2018 population estimates and recommended for COMPASS Board approval by the Finance Committee.

After discussion, Darin Taylor moved and Charlie Rountree seconded approval of the FY2019 General and Special member dues as recommended by the Finance Committee. Motion passed unanimously.

C. Approve *Communities in Motion 2040 2.0* (CIM 2040 2.0) Short-Term and Long-Term Funded Transportation Projects

Liisa Itkonen presented *Communities in Motion 2040 2.0* short-term and long-term funded regional capital projects, as recommended by the Regional Transportation Advisory Committee for COMPASS Board approval. Liisa requested that approval also allow staff to update the project information, if needed, such as removing projects completed this year from the list and to bring any changes as information to the COMPASS Board on August 20, 2018.

After discussion, Tom Dale moved and Jay Gibbons seconded approval of the *Communities in Motion 2040 2.0* short-term and long-term funded regional captial projects as presented. Motion passed. Rebecca Arnold, Elaine Clegg, and Karen Gallagher voted nay.

D. Approve Prioritization of *Communities in Motion 2040 2.0* (CIM 2040 2.0) Unfunded Transportation Projects

Liisa Itkonen presented prioritized lists of unfunded transportation needs to be included in CIM 2040 2.0.; divided into three categories: regional state roadway system, regional local roadway system, and regional public transportation, as recommended by the Regional Transportation Advisory Committee for COMPASS Board approval.

After discussion, Paul Woods moved and Stan Ridgeway seconded approval of the Communities in Motion 2040 2.0 unfunded regional state system corridors and projects, with the request that in future additions, the cleanup of the interchange at Beacon Light Road be addressed. Motion passed. Rebecca Arnold, Elaine Clegg, Karen Gallagher, and Jay Gibbons voted nay.

After discussion, **Darin Taylor moved and Elaine Clegg seconded approval of** the *Communities in Motion 2040 2.0* unfunded regional local system corridors and projects as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

After discussion, Elaine Clegg moved and Brent Orton seconded approval of the Communities in Motion 2040 2.0 unfunded regional public transportation system projects as prioritized.

After discussion, Darin Taylor moved a substitute motion and Tom Dale seconded approval of the *Communities in Motion 2040 2.0* unfunded regional public transportation system projects by reversing the priority order of No. 3 - Boise Downtown Circulator and No. 4 - ValleyConnect 2.0 Growth.

Chair Case called for a roll call vote on the substitute motion. Matt Stoll called roll.

F. Approve COMPASS Board Member Nomination as a Candidate for the National Association of Regional Councils' (NARC) Board of Directors

Matt Stoll stated that the Executive Committee recommended COMPASS Board approval of Garret Nancolas as a candidate for another 2 year term on the NARC Board of Directors.

After discussion, Tom Dale moved and Elaine Clegg seconded approval of Garret Nancolas as a candidate on the NARC Board of Directors. Motion passed unanimously.
