Chair Nancolas called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm.

Dave Case moved and Elaine Clegg seconded approval of the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

#### B. Status Report - I-84 Karcher to Franklin Project

Amy Schroeder, ITD District 3 Engineer Manager, presented a status report on the I-84 Karcher to Franklin project.

#### **ACTION ITEMS**

#### A. Review Economic Development District Proposal

Megan Larsen presented the draft Economic Development District (EDD) proposal for COMPASS to take over the Economic Development District function for Region 3 from the Idaho Council of Governments.

Jim Tibbs requested to invoke weighted voting. Dave Case and Megan Leatherman concurred.

After discussion, **Sara Baker moved and Bob Henry seconded to approve the draft Economic Development District proposal as presented by staff and move forward with the next steps; Finance Committee to develop budget and membership dues.** 

Matt Stoll called role for a weighted vote. Motion passed 459,346 to 356,610 with 19,583 abstentions.

The spreadsheet used in the meeting in error was based on FY2014 dues.

Following the meeting, votes were verified based on FY2015 dues as reflected on the spreadsheet below. With the counts based on correct dues, the motion passed 459,049 to 356,799, with 20,064 abstentions.

#### B. Consider Member Requested Changes to Draft Updates to the Joint Powers Agreement and Board Bylaws

Matt Stoll stated based on the approval of the Economic Development District proposal, which will necessitate additional changes to the Joint Powers Agreement and Board Bylaws, staff recommends moving this item to the June Board meeting and canceling the May Board meeting, which was primarily focused on providing 30 day notice of intent to amend the Joint Powers Agreement and Board Bylaws.

After discussion, **Bob Henry moved and Dave Case seconded to cancel the May 2015 Board meeting and continue Item VII-B Consider Member Requested Changes to Draft Updates to the Joint Powers Agreement and Board Bylaws to the June 2015 Board meeting. Motion passed unanimously.** 

### C. Adopt Resolution 11-2015 Amending the FY2015-2019 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Toni Tisdale presented Resolution 11-2015 amending the FY2015-2019 TIP as recommended for COMPASS Board approval by the Regional Technical Advisory Committee. Changes were requested by the Local Highway Technical Assistance Council on behalf of the City of Nampa, cities of Boise and Eagle, Valley Regional Transit and Ada County Highway District. A Public Comment period was held March 23 through April 6, 2015.

After discussion, **Darin Taylor moved and Dave Case seconded adoption of Resolution** 11-2015 amending the FY2015-2019 Regional Transportation Improvement Program as presented. Motion passed unanimously.
