CONSENT AGENDA

A. Approve March 30, 2016, RTAC Meeting Minutes

Clair Bowman moved and Nichoel Baird Spencer seconded approval of the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

ACTION ITEMS

A. Recommend Transportation Management Area (TMA) Program Balancing Actions for the FY2016-2020 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for COMPASS Board approval

Toni Tisdale presented requests from ACHD and VRT for balancing actions in the STP-TMA program.

After discussion, **Rhonda Jalbert moved and Justin Lucas seconded to recommend the TMA balancing actions for the FY2016-2020 TIP as presented for COMPASS Board approval. Motion passed unanimously.**

Amy Schroeder presented an Idaho Transportation Department request to amend the FY2016-2020 TIP to increase the cost on Key No. 18950 SH-44 Canyon Canal Bridge, Middleton, for COMPASS Board approval. After discussion, **Clair Bowman moved and Wendy Howell seconded approval of** amending the FY2016-2020 TIP as requested for COMPASS Board approval. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Approve COMPASS FY2017 Freight Study Scope of Work

Walt Satterfield presented the FY2017 freight study scope of work, primary tasks, and major outcomes for the freight component of *Communities in Motion 2040* 2.0, as identified by the Freight Advisory Workgroup.

After discussion, **Clair Bowman moved and Jeff Lowe seconded approval of the freight component of** *Communities in Motion 2040 2.0* **as presented, with the addition of a task for an ordinance template for freight routes. Motion passed unanimously.**

A. Review Idaho Transportation Department's FY2017-2021 Draft State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)

Amanda LaMott reviewed new projects in ITD's FY2017-2021 STIP to be approved by the Idaho Transportation Board in October 2016.

B. Recommend Approval of Surface Transportation Program (STP) and Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Balancing Policy for COMPASS Board Approval

Toni Tisdale presented a draft policy for balancing priorities for STP and TAP funds for COMPASS Board approval, which blends the prioritization and balancing guidance from the TMA Balancing Committee guidelines, MPO STP-Urban Rule Book, and ITD Admin Policy 5011 under one "umbrella." The policy will guide programming, and provide the ability to quickly program funds by following an establish policy, which will enables the region to ensure obligation.

After discussion, **COMPASS staff was directed to continue developing the draft policy based on input from RTAC members**, and bring back to RTAC at the May 25, 2016, meeting for consideration of approval.
