CALL TO ORDER:

OPEN DISCUSSION/ANNOUNCEMENTS

General announcements were made.

Carl Miller requested additional volunteers to sit on the Performance Measure Framework Workgroup. Drew Alexander, Nichoel Baird Spencer, Tom Ferch, and Stephen Hunt were added to the workgroup.

CONSENT AGENDA

A. Approve April 25 and Special May 2, 2018, RTAC Meeting Minutes

Nathan Leigh moved and Chris Hopper seconded approval of the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

SPECIAL ITEM

A. Review of Federal Certification Review

Scott Frey, Federal Highway Administration, provided an overview of the COMPASS federal Certification Review process, including potential outcomes and review focus areas.

ACTION ITEMS

A. Recommend FY2018-2022 Regional Transportation Improvement Program Amendment

Toni Tisdale presented an amendment to the FY2018-2022 Regional Transportation Improvement Program to delay a bridge replacement project on 10th Avenue in Caldwell.

After discussion, Chris Hopper moved and Gordon Bates seconded to recommend COMPASS Board of Directors' approval of Resolution 09-2018 amending the FY2018-2022 Regional Transportation Improvement Program as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Recommend End-of-Year Program and Redistribution Priorities

Toni Tisdale presented End-of-Year Program and redistribution priorities, for COMPASS Board of Directors' approval should additional funding become available. Four priorities were recommended: increase all program obligation to 100% of allocation (overall #1 priority), State Street/Collister Drive intersection in Boise (Transportation Management Area [TMA] #1 priority), bicycle and pedestrian bridge over the Boise River in Eagle (TMA #2 priority), and Colorado Avenue/Holly Street intersection signal and pedestrian improvements in Nampa (Nampa Urbanized Area #1 priority).

Tom Ferch said ACHD has a FY2020 local maintenance project and is requesting funding for design in FY2018 be added to the redistribution priorities list as TMA #3 priority.

After discussion, Clair Bowman moved and Justin Lucas seconded that RTAC, including ACHD's request, recommend COMPASS Board of Directors' approval of the End-of-Year Program and redistribution priorities as presented. Motion passed unanimously.
