A. Status Report and Next Steps for Communities in Motion 2040 (CIM 2040)

MaryAnn Waldinger said CIM 2040 will be done and in draft format by February 2014. The plan will go through public comment August 5 – September 4, 2013, with open houses for review of prioritized corridors scheduled for August 14, and 15, 2013. The plan will be presented to COMPASS' technical committees and then to the COMPASS Board by September 2014 for approval. One of the biggest and most important tasks is developing a funded, and unfunded, transportation list, which will be done by September 2014. Technical committee members will be notified prior to the public comment period and if there are questions, they can be directed to Liisa Itkonen.
