A. Approve June 24, 2015, RTAC Meeting Minutes

C. Review Reporting Requirements for Transportation Funding

Susan Lasuen, Local Highway Technical Assistance Council, discussed wording in HB 312 that requires all local highway jurisdictions to report on the new maintenance funds and how they are spent. Susan reviewed a draft of the updates to the Road & Street Financial Report to include the new reporting mechanism.
