### A. Approve September 26, 2012 Meeting Minutes

### **ACTION ITEM**

## A. Recommend Prioritization Process for Transportation Alternatives Program

Toni Tisdale discussed a proposed process for the Transportation Alternatives Program.

After discussion, Ryan Head moved and Nichoel Baird Spencer seconded to recommend the Transportation Alternatives Prioritization Process as presented with the modification to add information related to the flexible nature of the funds, to limit the number of votes per agency to one, to allow for participants on the scoring committee to vote for their own projects, and to require that the ballots be transparent with the voter's name being revealed together with their votes cast.

After further discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

### INFORMATION/DISCUSSION ITEM

# A. Discuss Proposed Changes to the Functional Classification Map for CIM 2040

Charles Trainor presented the Functional Classification Map for CIM 2040 and requested discussion regarding proposed arterial road changes.

### Discussion:

- Canyon County:
  - Canyon Street in Nampa, from Lone Star to Lake Lowell; it is functioning as a collector;
  - o 6<sup>th</sup> Street North from Northside to 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue would become a collector;
  - Happy Valley north of Flamingo is still coded as a principal arterial even though it is a local road inside the Gateway shopping center;

- Ustick from Middleton to McDermott should be a principal arterial rather than a minor arterial; and,
- o Midland from Cherry Lane to US 20/26 would be a principal arterial

### ACHD:

o remove road sections south of the Kuna/Mora corridor

Charles said the proposed changes will be implemented and the map will be presented to this Committee for recommendation at the November meeting. Depending on the nature and number of proposed changes, recommendations may go the COMPASS Board for action in December 2012. The map will go out for public comment early next year.

# B. Discuss Development of FY2014 Unified Planning and Work Program (UPWP)

Keith Holmes discussed the basic elements of the process and timelines.

Don Matson discussed the process for developing the core programs for the FY2014 UPWP. Don said volunteers are needed to help review the member agencies' submittals for Requests for Services. Forms are anticipated to be available prior to the November 28 meeting and potential projects will be discussed on December 19, 2012 and January 23, 2013. A special workshop will be held in conjunction with the November 28 meeting to identify regional needs and potential projects.
