CONSENT AGENDA

A. Approve September 26, 2018, RTAC Meeting Minutes

Nathan Leigh moved and Tom Ferch seconded approval of the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

ACTION ITEMS

A. Recommend COMPASS Board of Directors' Adoption of Resolution Approving the Communities in Motion 2040 2.0 (CIM 2040 2.0) Plan

Liisa Itkonen presented the CIM 2040 2.0 plan, as the regional long-range transportation plan for Ada and Canyon Counties, for COMPASS Board adoption.

After discussion, Patricia Nilsson moved and Gordon Bates seconded to recommend the COMPASS Board of Directors' adoption of Resolution X-2019 adopting *Communities in Motion 2040 2.0*, and directed staff to incorporate changes as presented. Motion passed. Zach Piepmeyer voted nay.

Liisa reviewed a proposal for future policy updates.

After discussion, Chair Baird Spencer directed staff to refine the policy statement with more detail and outline why updates are necessary for RTAC review in November.

B. Recommend COMPASS Board of Directors' Adoption of Resolution Amending the FY2018-2022 and FY2019-2023 Regional Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs)

Kathy Parker presented amendments to the FY2018 -2022 and FY2019-2023 TIPs as requested by ITD, increasing funding for construction for the State Highway 55 Snake River Bridge project near the City of Marsing, for COMPASS Executive Committee adoption subject to COMPASS Board of Directors' ratification at the December 2018 Board meeting.

After discussion, Patricia Nilsson moved and Clair Bowman seconded to recommendation COMPASS Executive Committee adoption of Resolution X-2019 amending the FY2018-2022 and FY2019-2023 Regional Transportation Improvement Programs as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

C. Approve Revised Development Review Protocol

Carl Miller reviewed the Demographic Advisory Workgroup's requested changes to the development review protocol for COMPASS Executive Director's approval. Revisions are needed to allow COMPASS staff to focus efforts on reviewing developments that will have the most impact on the regional transportation system.

After discussion, Clair Bowman moved and Deanna Smith seconded that RTAC recommend the Development Review Protocol revisions to the COMPASS Executive Director for approval. Motion passed. Tom Ferch, Maureen Gresham, and Justin Lucas voted nay.

A. Review Project Development Program

Kathy Parker reviewed proposed revisions to the Project Development Program.

After discussion, it was agreed to form an RTAC subcommittee to review the proposed changes in detail and provide a recommendation back to RTAC.
