A. Approve October 28, 2015, RTAC Meeting Minutes

INFORMATION/DISCUSSION ITEM

A. Discuss STP-TMA Funding policy for CIM 2040 2.0 (percent allocation)

Sabrina Minshall discussed the funding allocation in the STP funding policy for CIM 2040 2.0., which directs that the majority of the federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funding be focused on maintaining the existing transportation system.

After discussion, it was agreed by consensus to move forward with discussion of this item over several RTAC meetings, beginning with discussion of the history of the current policy, maintenance needs in the region, the financial forecast, and resource levels and availability of all funds covered in CIM not just STP.

A. Recommend Amending the FY2015-2019 and FY2016-2020 Regional Transportation Improvement Programs (TIP)

Toni Tisdale reviewed amendments to the FY2015-2019 and FY2016-2020 TIPs for COMPASS Board approval as requested by the Idaho Transportation Department and Valley Regional Transit.

After discussion, Clair Bowman moved and Justin Lucas seconded to recommend amending the FY2015-2019 and FY2016-2020 Regional Transportation Improvement Programs for COMPASS Board approval as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Recommend Amending the TIP Amendment Policy

Toni Tisdale presented changes to the TIP Amendment Policy to simplify the policy, incorporate best practices, requested changes by FHWA, and comments from RTAC members provided after the October 2015 RTAC meeting.

After discussion, Justin Lucas moved and Clair Bowman seconded to recommend approval of the changes to the TIP Amendment Policy for COMPASS Board approval as presented. Motion passed unanimously.
