C. Discuss STP-TMA Funding Policy for CIM 2040 2.0 (percent of allocation)

Sabrina Minshall lead discussion on the history of the funding allocation in the STP-TMA program for CIM 2040 2.0.

A. Recommend Amendment to FY2015-2019 and FY2016-2020 Regional Transportation Improvement Programs (TIP)

Toni Tisdale presented an amendment to the FY2015-2019 and FY2016-2020 TIPS for COMPASS Board approval as requested by ACHD, ITD, and City of Boise.

Karen Gallagher requested changing the description of the City of Boise project, Pathway, Eckert Road Underpass, Boise (13913), from "...and the project included ineligible termini." to "...and City of Boise pulled the project due to lack of funding."

After discussion, Karen Gallagher moved and Chris Hopper seconded recommending the amendment to FY2015-2019 and FY2016-2020 Regional Transportation Improvement Programs for COMPASS Board approval. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Prioritize STP Applications and Review Priorities of Additional Projects for FY2017-2021 Regional Program Transportation Improvement (TIP)

Toni Tisdale and Walt Satterfield presented applications for the FY2017-2021 TIP as prioritized by subcommittees of RCC and RTAC, based on eligibility of funds. RTAC prioritized applications eligible for STP funds using the Audience Response System. Final prioritization and funding recommendations will be finalized by RTAC in January 2016 for COMPASS Board approval.

After discussion, Jeff Lowe moved and Jeff Barnes seconded to accept the ranking of projects as they currently stand.
